# Executive Order 2023-17

- ▼ Signed by Governor Shapiro on July 31, 2023
- ▼ Created Commonwealth Workforce Transformation Program (CWTP)
- ▼ Allocates up to \$400M in funding
- ▼ Creates up to 10,000 new jobs over 5 years



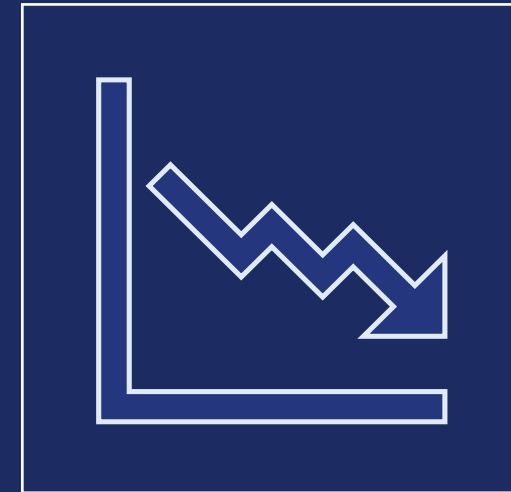
# Why the CWTP?

# What is an Eligible Organization?

- ▼ Entities that received an IJA or IRA contract, subcontract, grant, or subgrant from a Commonwealth agency
- ▼ Entities that receive federal tax credits worth \$10,000,000



# For how much can an Eligible Organization Apply?

Up to \$40,000

Total grant available per  
new employee

Up to \$400,000

Total grant available per  
new project

# How Does it Work?

Eligible Organization receives funding through IJA/IRA programs

Clean Energy

Transportation

Infrastructure

CWTP approves Eligible Organization for participation with program

Eligible Organization hires and trains New Employee for six (6) months

Pre-apprenticeship

Apprenticeship

On-the-job training

Eligible Organization applies for reimbursement

# Project Example #1 - Private Company

Applies for IJA grant to remediate orphaned wells

Receives \$8M IJA award for project

Notified by CWTP of program eligibility

Trains 5 employees on IJA project for 6 months

Submits for \$200,000 reimbursement through CWTP

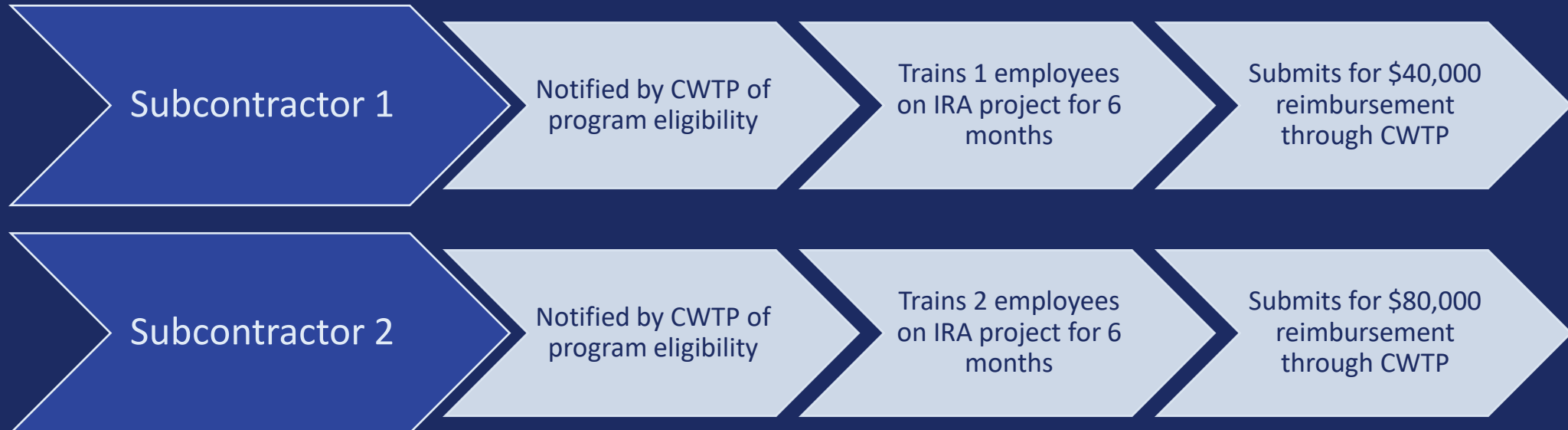
# Project Example #2

## Local Government

Applies for IRA grant to install solar

Receives \$5M IRA award for project

Procures subcontractors 1 & 2 to install solar
